No Limits! Art Castle

Chapters two and three take place at [No Limits Art Castle](#), the first art space in the Netherlands that stands for an art world without borders. No boundaries between so-called 'outsider' artists and the rest of the art world, not between art and design, not between day and night culture or fantasy and reality.

On view are two solo exhibitions: *Less is Bore* by Johan Vanderschelden is a posthumous retrospective. Vanderschelden was a collector par excellence who transformed his finds into a vibrant multitude with pride and inexhaustible enthusiasm.

Burn them All by Jordan Røge+ features a series of fairytale castles in ceramics. The sculptures remind us of the lies in fairy tales, where individuals can only be happily married if they conform to heteropatriarchal norms. The artist wants to build new empires, invent different stories and societies that are resolutely more inclusive and joyful.
